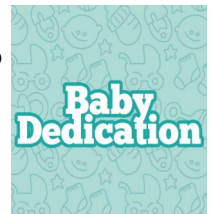
If you volunteered to help with the opportunity we have to minister at Big Elm, please meet up front on the organ side of the auditorium after tonight’s service.
