ALL CHILDREN'S CHURCH LEADERS please meet down front on the organ side for a brief meeting immediately following tonight's service.



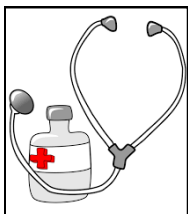
LOOKING AHEAD...We are looking forward to have the Stalcup Family with us on February 21st during the evening service!
